

PROTECT YOUR KEYS TIPS

Your keys are very valuable. Do Not Leave them laying on tables or out in public access. Be aware of your keys.

Everyone has a Camera Phone these days. Take the time right now and photograph your keys. This picture may be the only way you can describe or identify your key ring one day if your keys are lost.

Do Not put your Name, Address, Phone Number, or other personally identifying information on your key ring. Thieves may use this information to target you for criminal activity in the future.

OUR ALTERNATIVE:

Purchase a Member's ID Tag from American Key Recovery Service and The Keeper of the Keys.

For \$24.95, you receive (3) Key Tags for your Keys that will offer a REWARD if your keys are found, creating an incentive for someone to return your keys.

The Tags contain the information REWARD and a Phone Number, along with your Member's ID Number for easy identification and notification if your keys are found. We maintain a Confidential Member's Database of Information (for 5 years) to contact you if your keys are found. A Website is also available that explains the process for returning keys, and about our program. This combination provides a very high likelihood your keys will be returned if they are found.

None of your personal information is contained on the keys or Tags, only a Member's Registration Number that we use to identify you and return your keys.
